COVID-19 Do's and Don't April 2021

DOs:

- Always make reasonable endeavours to observe the 2 metre separation social distancing rule from non-family members, both on and off the green
- Only use your own bowls to play, the use of club bowls is not allowed
- Pay your membership fee prior to making rink bookings
- Make a confirmed rink booking through the duty rink booking co-ordinator before going to the Club, see website for details.
- Arrive at the club no more than 10 minutes before your allotted bowling session and leave promptly once you have returned the shared equipment to the shed and sanitized it.
- Ensure you have the code to open the combination locks on the shed. A key is no longer required.
- Whilst playing keep within the bounds of the rink you have booked.
- Ensure you sanitize the shared bowling equipment you use before and after use
- Ensure the rule of six or no more two families on the rink rules are always followed
- Ensure there are no more than <u>24 players</u> on the bowling green at any time.

DON'Ts:

- Don't go into the clubhouse, unless it is to use the toilets. The clubhouse is out of bounds for all members, except those on official duties as authorised by the committee
- Don't go to the club unless you have an agreed rink booking slot
- Don't use the shared club bowls to play
- Don't pick up other players bowls
